

# Lieutenant Warren G. Bisdorf III (1955-2019)

Warren was born January 30, 1955 to Hamilton City Prosecutor Warren G. Bisdorf, Jr. and Mary Lee (Winnefeld) Bisdorf. He graduated from St. Ann Grade School (1969), Badin High School (1973), and cum laude from American University in Washington, D.C.

Following in his father's and grandfather's footsteps Warren worked his way through school as a movie projectionist.



After college, Warren joined the District of Columbia Metropolitan Police Department. He was promoted through the ranks to Lieutenant. He retired and, after a decades'-long hiatus, returned to Butler County.

During June 1998, Lieutenant Warren joined the Miami Police Department as a Dispatcher. On March 20, 2003, he also joined the Oxford Police Department as a Dispatcher. He served both until his death.

He patrolled with his local neighborhood watch, was a mentor for Big Brothers/Big Sisters, and worked the polls for many elections.

After 40 years of service to his communities, Lieutenant Bisdorf passed away unexpectedly on Friday, March 8, 2019 at the age of 64.

Lieutenant Bisdorf is survived by his wife of almost 40 years, Shirleen Faye (Martin) Warren; daughter Pamela (Richard) Darone; grandchildren, Savannah Darone, Evan Darone and Austin Darone; and siblings, Mark (Kathy) Warren, Helen (Mike) Pope, Diane (Carlos) Valero, and Carmelle (Mike) Cieslak.
